



#### SECA Art Camp 2018

The children created over 500 studies, drawings and paintings. We selected almost 200 examples for this year's show.

Each day started with a warmup drawing to get our minds focused and our hands coordinated. Some of these were the child's choice and some were assignments: plant and vegetable studies, studies of animals, musical instruments, flower studies.



Pencils of different weights, two varieties of pen (brush and gel), tempera paint, watercolor, a variety of brushes different ways to organize a paint palette, high quality papers of different types, printing ink, materials to make printing plates, small watercolor cards and envelopes for artist's cards, stretched canvas of varying sizes were part of the camp sessions.

After working on large studies from animal models, large still life set-ups, or perhaps several smaller studies, each child could then continue working from life or make up imaginary images. Sometimes we would suggest ideas for them to take off from. Often something in the assignments would trigger an imaginary idea. It was fun to see these ideas appear on their papers, prints and canvases.

Our young artists were kindergarten through early middle school ages. We needed to adjust the assignments for this broad an age spectrum. Some students did their best work from life others from imagination. Working from life can be a wonderful end in itself or the place for the imagination to grow and develop. Each week, while we drew, we had lessons in botany and zoology, color and design and our hands and eyes were becoming more coordinated. We were beginning to see that the sky touches the ground and isn't just at the top of the page and that animals have differing textures, colors and patterns.

This was a focused and talented group of children. They worked hard but also had a lot of laughter and fun.

We would like to thank the Carlson Trust for making it possible, the SECA board and director, Nicole Luecker, for providing the space and coordinating the sessions in the SECA schedule and most of all the parents - several of whom were a tremendous help.


