Pennsylvania leads the nation in Pardon Reform!

- Before the bill was passed, less than 5% could hope to get a pardon. Today, more than 70% of those who apply for a pardon are granted one
- A pardon forgives you for your crime and gives you a REAL second chance
- NEVER "CHECK THE BOX" AGAIN!
- A pardon opens the doors to jobs and careers, educational opportunities and other rights and privileges because your criminal record is erased for good

Do I qualify?

- Do you have a criminal record in Pennsylvania?
- Did your crime not involve sex or violence to another person or a child?
- Has it been at least 3 years since you completed your sentence (including probation or parole?)
- Has your record been clean since your last arrest?
- Do you not have enough money to hire a lawyer to help you?

 We are your neighbors – a network of dedicated community aid agencies, lawyers, and volunteers trained in pardons and working together to help people write the best pardon applications you can so you have the best chance for a pardon
