I did the last of my One Book Every Young Child outreach visits and tours in April. I did two visits at Kids Express in Willow Street and a library tour for Willow Street Preschool. I did my usual outreach story time at Shining Stars in Quarryville, a book crate each for Noah's Ark and Willow Street Pre-K, and a classroom kit for the Linville Hill Fourth Grade class. Finally, the Qville Headstart visited for a Preschool Power Story Time!

The Maker Fest in early April went extremely well, with about 70 people of all ages filtering through throughout the day. There has been interest expressed that we repeat this program annually from both attendees and presenters, so we will try to plan another for next spring. I'm planning a new teen book club, a series of outreach visits at SECA, kids' yoga, and parachutes for older children. All of these programs are on our calendar, and handouts for specific age groups have been prepared as take-aways.
